JEROME GRIMMER IS BACK!

Jerome Grimmer began giving demonstrations in the early



1970's when acrylic was a relatively new fine-art medium that few artists knew how to use. He discovered ways to work with it that earned him many competitive awards. Responding to requests for demonstrations from art clubs throughout California and Arizona, he freely shares

his techniques. Today he is widely sought as a teacher and art show judge.

Grimmer received his training at Art Center College of Design where he majored in illustration. He worked briefly as a commercial illustrator in the aerospace field and for three years in the Navy before launching a career as a fine art painter. To help provide income during the first years, he worked as an illustrator in the greeting card industry and as a successful printing salesman. In 1975, he had his first of many one-man shows. Some of the finest and most respected art galleries in California and Arizona have represented his work.

Grimmer divides his time between his studio-home in Oakhurst and his Midwest studio-home with his wife, Karen, near St. Louis.

On Wednesday the 22nd, is our artist reception and award ceremony, so please sign up to bring in finger foods and come to the reception! Invite your family, friends and customers to see your art! Finally, on Sunday afternoon we are going to need more ablebodied artists to assist in taking down the show. Our art show will only be as good as the support you give and I know I can count on all of you to step up and volunteer.


