Entries due at the I General Meeting


#### **Open to All Clovis Art Guild Members**.

# Featured Artist Susan Patterson

Featured artist is a way for our members to get to know each other by showing everyone their work in the safe environment of a general meeting. Susan has always loved art. Her first introduction was at about age 6 when a friend of the family, an art teacher at Roosevelt High School, took her to class for the day. Another big influence was seeing the Van Gogh exhibit in Los Angeles at age 12. Susan says she is inspired by God's creation, especially flowers and animals. Susan stated that "she thinks of the watercolor process as an emotional experience. Watching the colors mingle brings great joy. The word that sums up my art experience is Joy. It gives me joy to paint and I want my paintings to bring joy to others. That is my goal. And I want to bring glory to God for His beautiful creation and His goodness".

Susan has not had much formal training in art. Her journey into watercolor began nine years ago with watercolor lessons at the Clovis Senior Center. That was after she retired from a pediatric nurse position with 43 years at Valley Childrens Hospital. She also took one year of art lessons with Ma Ly, at his Vernissage Art Gallery. More recently she has been taking online watercolor classes from Birgit O'Conner.

Susan has received a number of awards, including Best of Show for her watercolor, "Hope Blooms", at the Sanger Hope Art Show, Peoples Choice award for "His Rose" at the Clovis Art Guild Fall show 2022, at the Armenian home, and the Mary Krauss award at the 2023 Clovis Art Guild Old West and Rodeo Art Show for "Jelly Rising ". Most recently she was awarded First Place for "His Glory" at the 2023 Clovis Fall Art Guild Show.

Susan would like to continue to grow in her use of watercolors to express the beauty around us. Her passion though is painting flowers, large and close-up. At least for now.
