



Location: Sierra Vista Mall, Clovis, CA, room 1041 **unless otherwise stated from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 P.M.**

All art must be for sale. Acceptable Media: All fine art painting or drawing media (oil, pastel, acrylic, watercolor, pencil, charcoal, etc.), mixed media and Sculpture. Metal, Clay, woodcarving, ceramics, paper Mache', glass art, etc. are all acceptable media. Sculptures must weigh less than 20# and should be large enough to sit on the floor or you must bring a stand and be responsible for moving it yourself. This is an sales exhibit, not a juried show so Classwork, Giclee prints of your work, or older works are acceptable. Prints must be clearly marked as prints. **We will try to hang everything brought in but not all art may be hung due to space limitations.**

- All paintings or Prints must be framed; gallery wrap (1.5" to 2" wide on the edge) is acceptable. Use of metal frames is at the risk of the artist.
- Frames must be in good repair and ready to hang. The maximum size is 24 x 36 maximum weight 10 lbs.
- Please use flat hangers with wires only, no Saw-tooth, eyelet hangers or quick frames and no screw eyes. The ends of the wire must be taped or sleeved.
- Screws for hanging must be no more than 4" inches from the top of the frame and the wire must not show over the top of the frame.
- All oils must be completely dry. Watercolor, Drawing and some types of mixed media must be under glass or plexi-glass, unless larger than 24" x 28" and then plexi-glass is required
- An Exhibit card with the title, price media and your contact information will be provided for you to fill out at receiving.
- The Artist is responsible for picking up art at the end of the gallery exhibit. Storage is not an option. If you can't pick up your own work on the date specified, please make other arrangements for it to be picked up at that time.
- Art is hung in the Storefront Art Gallery at your own risk. The Storefront Art Gallery, Sierra Vista Mall and Clovis Art Guild are not responsible for damage or loss of your artwork.
- Removal of the art for any reason must be done through the Exhibit Coordinator.
- This is a member's only exhibit and there is no entry fee. You may join during receiving.
- If you sell your art contact the Exhibit coordinator before attempting to remove the art. Security at the mall will not allow you entry without the coordinators permission. It would be appreciated if you would stay and help hang or receive.

If you sell art out of the window, a 10% donation to Clovis Art Guild is appreciated.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTRY

Pick of the month is an informal contest created to support our member's efforts. Because it is informal, we do allow work that has been done in class as well as that done independently. Pick Of The Month is held at each monthly meeting except October when all 1st place winners compete for Pick of the Year. We need at least 7 paintings to award 3 places, so please participate! We'd like to see what you've been working on! Art should be finished and in ready to hang condition. Acceptable Media: All fine art painting or drawing media (oil, pastel, acrylic, watercolor, pencil, charcoal, etc.) mixed media, and sculpture.

- Sculptures must weigh less than 20# and should fit on the display table or you must bring a stand.
- All paintings must be framed; gallery wrap (3/4" to 2" wide and painted on the edge) is acceptable. The maximum size is 24 x 36 maximum weight 10 lbs.
- Frames must be in good repair
- All oils must be completely dry. Watercolor, Drawing and some types of mixed media must be under glass or plexi-glass, unless larger than 24" x 28" and then plexi-glass is required
- There is no entry fee

Art not meeting these standards may be refused entry by our Pick of the Month Chair.

Note: During Pick of the Year, we do allow artists to present a print or a copy in lieu of the original art. This is because we recognize that the original may have been sold or entered in another art show. If you are bringing in a print for Pick of the Year, please mount it on cardboard or whiteboard so that it will stand upright with the rest of the art.
